Three-quarters actual size.

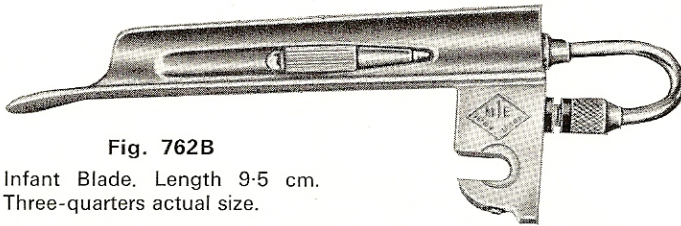
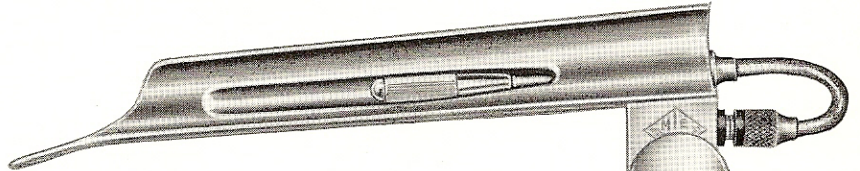

Three-quarters actual size.

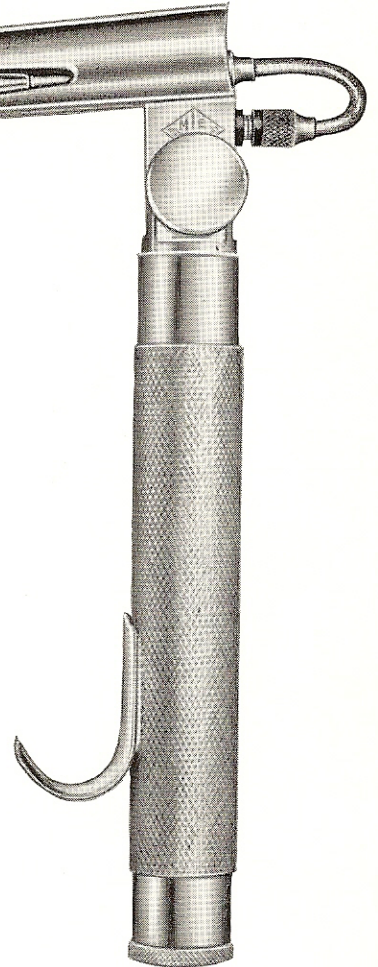

The Anderson laryngoscope has a handle of 'fountain pen' size with a conveniently positioned finger hook. Its balance enables the anaesthetist to have complete control at all times.

The modified infant and child Magill pattern detachable blades are of high quality stainless steel, thus obviating the danger and difficulties associated with chromium plating.

DETACHABLE LIGHTING STEMS – facilitate sterilisation and lamp replacement. Sterilisation of blade may be carried out by boiling.

These instruments are fully interchangeable with previous models.
